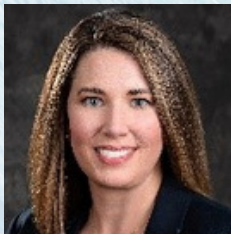
Are You in Charge, or Are You a Leader?
